**12.- ADARRÓ BEACH.** Getting off here will give you direct access to the Adarró, La República and Ribes Roges beaches. You will also be very close to the sculpture of Pasifae, and even closer to the Ibero-Roman archaeological site of Adarró. What's more, if you wander up the Sant Gervasi hill, you will be rewarded with a marvellous view of this delightful beach.

**11.- RIBES ROGES.** Enjoy the summer calm of the Plaça del Consolat de Mar – a real luxury. From here you can also walk along to the Passeig de Ribes Roges and really enjoy being right on the sea front under this Mediterranean light which bathes our town.

**10.- STATION.** At the Plaça d'Eduard Maristany you will be right next to the Catalonia Railway Museum – one of the most important railway museums in Europe – the train and bus station, and the Library-Museum Biblioteca Museu Víctor Balaguer. Two museums that you really have to visit!

**9.- CENTRE MARKET.** From Rambla de Salvador Samà you can reach the Mercat del Centre, which has recently celebrated its 75th anniversary, and also move on to visit the busy shopping areas on Avinguda de Francesc Macià and Carrer de Josep Coroleu.

**8.- RAMBLA PRINCIPAL.** If the Plaça de la Vila is the heart of the town then the Rambla Principal is its backbone. The Rambla Principal and the Rambla de la Pau together go on for 1.2 kms and connect the old Vilanova, from the Plaça de les Neus, with its maritime façade. A leisurely stroll with plane trees, bars, cafés, shops and restaurants on either side.



**1.- TOURIST OFFICE.** The Tourist Information Office is located in the middle of the sea front area of Vilanova i la Geltrú. From here you can visit the Ribes Roges park area and beach, the Club Nàutic and of course the emblematic Passeig del Carme where you can find a wide variety of bars, cafés and restaurant to satisfy anyone's gastronomic tastes.

# TRAIN STOPS

**7.- LA GELTRÚ.** Plaça dels Lledoners is without doubt the perfect place to begin your walk around the Geltrú neighborhood, discover its most intimate secrets and enjoy visiting the Castle, the Church or the Plaça de l'Assumpció. And if you wander further into the old Vilanova you will come across the Can Papiol Romantic Museum.



**2.- DOCK AREA.** At the end of the dock area you will find the Daurada Beach Club, the Vilanova Grand Marina, or the marine activity centre Roc Roi. From here you can enjoy a wonderful panoramic view of one of the Vilanova i la Geltrú's beaches.

**3.- ESPAI FAR.** In the Espai Far you will find the Sea Museum and the Roig Toqués Marine Curiosities Museum together. It is also the ideal place to enjoy the Sant Cristòfol Lighthouse beach and Hermitage building, the fishing port area and the fish auction.

**4.- LA TORRE BLAVA (Blue Tower) -** Guinovart Place is one of the heritage treasures of this city. Besides, it connects directly with the Ribes Roges promenade, the Carme promenade and the beaches.

**5.- RAMBLA DE LA PAU.** Here you are very close to the Mercat de Mar and Baixamar park, in the midst of a pedestrian area with many quality shops and bars and restaurants. This area is not so well-known and definitely a pleasant surprise for anyone who visits here.

**6.- CARROS SQUARE** or the charismatic Soler i Gustems square plaça dels Carros – as it is popularly known – is the perfect natural starting place to visit the shopping streets Sant Sebastià, Caputxins and Sant Gregori. Near here you will also find the real heart of Vilanova i la Geltrú – the West Indian town square Plaça de la Vila.
