## OFICINA DE TURISME

Stroll around and enjoy the sports facilities of Ribes Roges Park and Beach. There are plenty of eating-out options on Passeig del Carme.

## GRAND MARINA

The port affords superb panoramic views of the beaches and the city. Leisure and recreational area.

## PLATJA DE RIBES ROGES

The seafront of one of the largest and prettiest beaches on the Barcelona Coast. Check out the beach services provided and cool down at a beach snack bar.

## PLATJA D'ADARRÓ

Stop with direct access to Adarró and La República beaches. Right next to the Pasiphaë sculpture, Sant Gervasi Beach and the Adarró Iberian-Roman site.

## PLAÇA DEL CONSOLAT DE MAR

Enjoy the summer calm of the square, take a stroll to Passeig de Ribes Roges and soak up the Mediterranean light on the seafront.

## FIRA PARK

Very close to Gumà i Ferran Park where you can relax and enjoy the greenery. Next to the Pia School.

## CAN PAHISSA

In the heart of La Rambla, a landmark Catalan Modernist building. You'll find an array of eateries in this part of town. As you head up the Rambla you enter the main shopping district.

## PLAÇA DELS CARROS

Gateway to the shopping district. Streets: St. Sebastià, St. Gregori, Caputxins, rambla Principal and Central Market. Right next to plaça de la Vila, the heart of the town.

## MUSEU DEL FERROCARRIL DE CATALUNYA

This museum boasts one of the finest railway locomotive collections in Europe. Meanwhile, the Victor Balaguer Library-Museum is a listed building of national interest. Right next to the train and bus stations.

## MERCAT DE MAR

Plaça de la Immaculada Concepció. The market and the pretty church of the Mar neighbourhood are located next to it.

## ESPAI FAR

This space houses the Maritime Museum and the Roig Taqués Maritime Curiosities Museum. Right next to El Far de Sant Cristófol Beach, the chapel, the fishing port and the Llotja del Peix (fish market).
